Midlands Accommodation & Food Services

The Midlands accommodation and food services sector in Ireland is experiencing a mixed outlook for 2025. While there's a focus on sustainable tourism development and some businesses are optimistic about visitor levels, cost pressures, particularly energy and payroll, remain a concern. Inbound tourism numbers saw a decrease in March 2025 compared to the previous year, but an increase compared to March 2023. The sector is also navigating evolving consumer preferences and adapting to new technologies. The Accommodation and Food Services sector in Ireland can be broadly divided into two main sub-sectors: Accommodation and Food and Beverage Service Activities. These divisions encompass a wide range of businesses providing lodging and dining experiences.

Employment Overview

The sector remains a significant employer, providing around 9,200 jobs representing nearly 6.0% of the region's total employment (CSO – 2025Q1). The sector is known for a high proportion of young workers (aged 15-24), who make up over 30% of the workforce. In 2023, seasonal work was most prevalent in the sector, accounting for 22.3% of employments, according to the CSO.
